FSBPA and the Tech Conference Planning Committee recognize the importance of providing students with this professional networking opportunity where they can highlight their research and meet professionals in related professions.

The conference will be awarding student scholarships that may be used for travel and other expenses to the 2024 Conference. Selected abstracts will be displayed as posters in the exhibit area at the conference. Students will present their poster and answer questions during designated professional breaks. Scholarships will be given to the top three student posters, and will be announced on Friday, February 9, during the general session.

Award

The top three student abstracts will be awarded a \$750, \$400 and \$250 scholarship that may be used to offset travel and other expenses. All selected students who present a poster will receive a complimentary registration to the Conference.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants can be enrolled as either full or part-time students.

Application Process

Students must submit an abstract along with a complete application form with the signature of a dean, advisor, or professor.

Deadline for Submission
The deadline to submit an application and abstract is December 19, 2023.

Poster Abstract Submittal

Abstract submittals must describe the content of the poster presentation and why it may be of interest to conference attendees. Abstracts should not exceed 2-pages in length and must be emailed in a Word or PDF format with complete contact information to abstracts@fsbpa.com.

Selection Criteria and Notification

Sponsors and the conference organizer will review applications and abstracts, and make the final selection of participating student abstracts. Students will be notified if their abstract was selected via email by January 3, 2024.

The winner of the scholarship and runner-ups will be announced during the conference.
